GX Configurator-PN does not support the use of two-byte characters.

- .NET Framework 3.5 (including .NET 2.0 and 3.0) or .NET Framework 4.8 Advanced Services needs to be enabled. For details, refer to TECHNICAL BULLETIN No. FA-A-0207.
- When the following functions are used, this product may not run properly.
 - Application start-up in Windows compatibility mode
 - Fast user switching
 - Remote desktop
 - Touch function
 - Virtual environment such as Client Hyper-V
 - Tablet mode
 - Virtual Desktops
 - Unified Write Filter
 - Text cursor indicator
- In the following cases, the screen of this product may not work properly.
 - The size of the text and/or other items on the screen are changed to values other than default values (such as 96 DPI, 100%, and 9 pt).
 - The resolution of the screen is changed in operation.
 - The Windows theme is changed in operation.
 - The multi-display is set.
- Use the product as a standard user or an administrator.

Installation

■ Items to be checked before installation

- Log on to the personal computer as an administrator.
- Close all running applications before installation. If the product is installed while other applications are running, it may not operate normally.
- Before installing GX Configurator-PN, check that GX Works3 with the latest version has been installed. If not installed, install GX Works3 first, and then install GX Configurator-PN.

1. Unzip the compressed folder.
2. Double-click "setup.exe" in the unzipped folder to start the installer.
3. Select or enter the necessary information by following the on-screen instructions.

- When GX Configurator-PN is installed successfully, a dialog box to prompt user to restart the computer appears. Before installation, save all the data being edited by any applications. Otherwise, data may be lost.
